Papers that focus on specific groups like long-term unemployed people or unemployed people who receive means-tested benefits are particularly welcome.

**Registration:** The submission deadline is June 14, 2006. Electronic versions of the papers have to be submitted in Post Script, PDF or MS Word format. There is no conference fee for participants who present a paper. For external participants who do not present a paper at the workshop the conference fee is  $\leq 100$ .

**Reimbursement of travel cost:** There is a small travel grant for Ph.D. students, who present a paper at the workshop and provide a letter of their supervisor that confirms their current Ph.D. student status. The grant covers 50 percent of the travel cost, but the grant is limited to a maximum of €150.
